

SSUMC Online Giving

To make a one-time donation, just click the appropriate button on the www.silverspringumc.org/give page and follow the instructions.

To set up recurring online giving, please take the following steps after clicking on the “Recurring Giving” button.

1. If you have an account on the Church Portal:

1. If you already have a username and password to our Church Portal, use that information to sign in after clicking on the “Recurring Giving” button on the www.silverspringumc.org/give page.
 1. If you successfully log in, proceed to Step 3 (Sign up for Online Giving) below.
 2. If you forgot your password, use the Forgot Password link.

2. If you do not have an account or aren't sure:

1. Fill in the fields listed in the form that appears on the page after clicking on the “Recurring Giving” button on the www.silverspringumc.org/give page.
2. Be sure to provide an active email address.
3. Once you provide the necessary information (including your mailing address) a one-time use link will be sent the email address provided.
4. Click on the link to access the giving registration/modification page.

3. Sign up for Online Giving.

1. Fill in the appropriate fields on the screen **Manage Recurring Giving**, including financial information, the contributions to specific accounts, the frequency of gifts, and the date of the first gift and click **Submit**.
 1. Note: It is less costly for the church to process electronic check (ACH) transactions directly from your bank account than credit card transactions.
 2. Security & Privacy: All information on the site is securely transmitted and stored on the servers. No one at the church will have access to your bank account or credit card information at any time. Only the Financial Secretary and his/her assistants can see your record of giving.
 3. Once you submit your information, you should get an email confirmation of your settings.
2. To manage your account, follow the same steps above to access the page to Manage Recurring Giving. Adjust the information as necessary!
